- 12. Maintain musical instruments and arrange for tuning and upkeep.
- 13. Organize and maintain choir robes.
- 14. Supervise accompanying musicians.
- 15. Coordinate with sound technician as needed.
- 16. Oversee budget and expenditures for the music ministry.
- 17. Optional: Play during weddings and funerals as employed by the individuals requesting such services.
